Yehans import aluminium profiles and accessories from Italy and undertakes the fabrications in our factory in Accra. Sizable portions of Yehans' products are for corporate institutions and the balance of work for individuals.

All materials used including sash and frame are extruded from aluminium alloy sistema R50s (6060T5), steel or thick coatings with strength and durability conforming to UNI 9006/1 specifications. All powder coated surfaces are anodized to obtain a minimum coating of 15 micrones and 25 micrones maximum conforming to UNI 4522 66 specifications and come in different colours.

We ensure that fabrication and installation meet international specifications which is why our work carries a three year warranty.
